The Briefing:

The state of Oaxaca is the poorest in Mexico. The majority of the 1 million indigenous Indians in Oaxaca live in remote mountain villages without electricity, running water, or indoor plumbing. Most have little to no formal education and as a result are not



able to read or write in either their own language or Spanish. They are castigated by the populations around them for their ancestry, traditions and language. Over 50% of these Indians speak no Spanish whatsoever while the rest speak only a limited amount. Even more heartbreaking than the abject poverty in which these Indians live is the spiritual poverty that

defines their existence. They are separated from the Good News of the Gospel of Christ by linguistic, geographic and cultural differences. Even though they live next door to one of the most Gospel saturated nations in the history of the world most of them have never, even once, heard a clear Gospel

presentation. Those who have heard the Gospel or are seeking the Truth do not have the Bible in their own language so that they can access it and they do not have a local church in which to gather to worship Christ and receive instruction and discipleship. Men, women, and children in Oaxaca are born into the darkness of sin and live lives of hopelessness apart from Christ. Will you have a part in taking the Good News of the Gospel of Christ to those who have never heard?

The Mission:

So what does all this have to do with me? As a Christian we are all tasked with the Great Commission. It is not the missionaries job to take the Gospel to a lost and dying world for the glory of Christ but the Christians job! Out of a love and obedience to Christ and what He did in paying for our sins on Calvary we ought to desire to see Him praised and worshipped in all the earth. Obviously not all Christians are called to go to Africa and Asia to preach the Gospel. Christ will call many to serve him at home, faithfully sharing the Gospel in their "Judea," but is that an excuse to forget the "uttermost parts of the World?" The Great

Commission is not an "or" but an "and!" Even if we are not called to go abroad ourselves we must pray diligently and give sacrificially to be obedient to our Lord and Savior.
