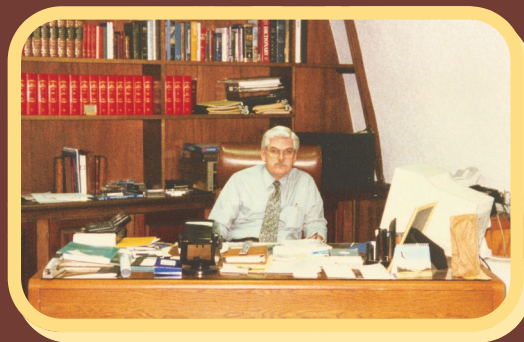


A New Call-A New Ministry-A New Life
